Location: Center Lake Bible Camp is located 3 ½ miles east of Tustin, Michigan on 20 Mile Road, approximately 12 miles south of Cadillac

Directions: ***From the West and South:*** Take US 131 north to the Tustin/Marion exit #168; then go east (right) four miles on 20 Mile Road to the Camp. ***From Detroit and East:*** Take US 10 to M-115; then M-115 to 20 Mile Road (Tustin/Marion Exit); Then west 7 ½ miles to camp. **Center Lake** is located 3 hrs from the Indiana/Michigan Border.

Capacity
